Hello Norm!

Thank you for your letter of 16 January. You have been busy, and I very much appreciate what you do on behalf of the NMCB 62 Alumni Group.

My wife and I don't travel very far any more so unfortunately we will not be able to make the Gulfport reunion. However, I have gone back through some old boxes and come up with a few things that might be of interest.

1. A listing of all the incidents and casualties along LTL-4 while we were there. I got the list from Paul Wollenhaupt, who kept a journal during the deployment. On a side note, I lost contact with Paul a couple of years ago. I've emailed and called him with no response. I've also spoken to Ron Barker, who visited Paul and few years ago, but has also lost contact. Perhaps you could put out an inquiry to see

if anyone knows anything about his condition. I know he was having some health issues the last time I had contact with him.

- 2. The most current roster of the Hill 55 group available. It was compiled by EOMC Wood, and supersedes the one on the 62 web page.
- 3. Two letters from MC Wood transmitting his efforts in keeping the Hill 55 roster current. I included these just to have a record of MC Wood's efforts.
- 4. The Hill 55 Group photo with the only names I can remember. I'm not sure about Sam Bass and John Tye. I am sure about me and Ron Roth though. I have not been able to locate the original photo, but am still looking. I have a clean digital copy if you need it.
- 5. You have a copy of the September 1970 Seabeacon on the 62 web page. There's a write-up on the LTL-4 detail on pages 8 and 9. Also there's a photo of a 14th century watch tower on the last page. This same structure withstood a nearby blast from the line charges used to detonate mines. It's shown during and after the blast on pictures 94,95, and 96 of the batch I sent you a while back.
- 6. The November 1970 Seabeacon has a nice piece written by LCDR Gerdel where he mentions the Hill 55 project. Page 7 of that publication has a picture of me operating a TD-20 dozer on LTL-4.
- 7. Although not related to Hill 55, I've attached a photo of the Operations group. I don't remember whether it was taken at Camp Haskins or Red Beach (it had to be either the beginning or the end of the deployment), but do remember a lot of the names (I wrote them down many years ago). The names are included with the photo. I thought this would add to the documentation of the 1970 deployment even if it's not tied directly to Hill 55.

I will continue to look for anything relevant in my stuff, and let you know if I find anything that might be of interest. Thanks Norm!

Dear Hill 55 Shipmates,

I am so very pleased to inform you that another Hill 55 Shipmate has been located, EO-3 William L. (Bill) Powell, now residing in Olathe, KS.

I'm sure you all remember Bill as one of our very versatile equipment operators in Det. Buford. On July 29, 1970 while operating a Cat D-8 dozer, Bill had the misfortune of detonating a land mine while working on highway LTL-4 just south of Hill 55. HM-3 (Doc) Cunningham and I determined that Bill had very possibly suffered a concussion, some burns, and possibly a broken leg from the explosion. He was medivaced by helicopter just 25 minutes later to a military medical facility at Danang for treatment. He was later medivaced to the Naval Hospital, Great Lakes, IL. for further treatment and rehabilitation. After 4 months in the Naval Hospital, he was separated and sent home. Petty Officer Powell was awarded the Purple Heart Medal for the injuries he sustained in this incident.

I am providing each of you an updated Det. Buford roster. I encourage each of you to establish some type of communications with our shipmates to renew our friendships and esprit de corps. We were a tight group on Hill 55 and I'd like to see that attitude continued now some 30 years later. I consider it a real privilege to have known each of you, and I appreciate all your hard work and dedication while you were under my leadership in Det. Buford. I also encourage each of you to continue your efforts of searching for Hill 55 Shipmates that we do not now have addresses.
