The History of NMCB SIXTY-TWO

United States Mobile Construction Battalion SIXTY-TWO is a proud unit with a noble heritage. Originally organized of construction workers from the Mid-West on 7 December 1942, and commissioned at Davisville, Rhode Island on 30 December 1942, the SIXTY-SECOND "MINUTEMAN" first won fame at Pearl Harbor where they built many of the facilities at the Submarine Base; some of them remain today. Later, after landing on Iwo Jima, they repaired and maintained captured enemy airstrips. The Battalion eventually moved to Japan where it was disestablished on 15 December 1945.

Since reestablishment at Gulfport, Mississippi on 2 July 1966, the Battalion has deployed to Vietnam four times to provide construction support for American forces in combat areas and to stand-by to fight if necessary. The Battalion has also deployed to Puerto Rico, the British Indian Ocean Territory island of Diego Garcia, the island of Guam and to Rota, Spain.

The Battalion first deployed to Vietnam in November 1967 and was assigned to the Hue-Phu Bai area. One of its most important projects was the huge heliport complex essential to the increased helicopter operations in the northern I Corps area. Working on an unfavorable site against monsoon weather, the MINUTEMEN placed 20 acres of soil cement and eight acres of steel matting for helicopter operating areas. Hangars, offices, living huts, fuel berms, drainage facilities and roads were also constructed in support of helicopter operations.

The Battalion's second deployment, which began in January 1968, based the men of SIXTY-TWO at Camp Haskins, Da Nang. Besides completing the construction of bulk fuel tanks, roads and bridges, the Battalion started Medical Civic Action Programs and deployed their first of many SEABEE teams, the Navy's Peace Corps.

The third Vietnam deployment, in March 1969, found the SEABEES involved in a wide variety of projects at Dong Ha. The most important was upgrading of 39 miles of highway in the Lines of Communication (LOC) program. Two other large projects consisted of a 448 foot bridge across the Cam Lo River and a 560 foot bridge across the Mieu Giang River. After returning home, the Battalion performed urgent repairs to facilities at CBC Gulfport and surrounding communities which had been damaged by Hurricane Camille.

During the fourth and final deployment to Da Nang, Vietnam, in May 1970, the Battalion's first priority mission was the completion of projects contributing to the program of Accelerated Turnover to the Vietnamese (ACTOV). The Battalion also upgraded highways, built living facilities for Marine Corps troops and constructed two river patrol boat bases in the Mekong Delta.

The "E" award for "Best of Type Atlantic Fleet Battalion" was awarded to SIXTY-TWO for Fiscal Years 1969 and 1970 for excellent performance. This honor is given each year to the outstanding Naval Mobile Construction Battalion in the Naval Construction Force. SIXTY-TWO also won the Peltier Award twice during that same two-year period. For 1972, SIXTY-TWO was named as the runner-up for the "Best of Type Atlantic Fleet Battalion."

After the Vietnam era, SIXTY-TWO deployed to Puerto Rico in 1971 and was assigned the demanding task as Atlantic Fleet Alert Battalion. There, the Battalion conducted an active Civic Action Program as had been done in Vietnam. After returning to homeport the "MINUTEMEN" prepared for what would be the most challenging peace time construction job ever faced by any Battalion: The building of a Naval Communication Station on the British controlled island of Diego Garcia, British Indian Ocean Territory.


The sixth deployment, in July 1972, saw SIXTY-TWO completing a Naval Communication Station, Diego Garcia, for commissioning. SIXTY-TWO also built the world's first coral aggregate, slip-form paved runway which is capable of handling nearly any aircraft in production. Other projects included storage warehouses, sewage lagoon, bachelor enlisted and officer quarters and power and desalinization plants.

SIXTY-TWO's seventh deployment, to Guam—the largest island in the Marianas chain—started in September 1973. The deployment provided NMCB SIXTY-TWO with a wide variety of challenging, permanent construction projects. The men learned and developed new technical skills; they also enjoyed outstanding recreational opportunities. Construction projects included a new Chief Petty Officers' Club for the Naval Communications Station, new headquarters building for the 30th Naval Construction Regiment, a swimming pool for the Naval Hospital and earthwork for the Naval Magazine. Besides the main body in Guam, SIXTY-TWO had details in Adak, Alaska; Midway Island; Atsugi, Japan; San Miguel, Philippines and Seabee Team 6209 was deployed to Truk Island.

During the last deployment, SIXTY-TWO again served as the Atlantic Fleet Alert Battalion. Construction projects at Rota included the ordnance area security zone improvements, rehabilitation of BEQ 31, an ASTAC facility, Seabee Camp rehabilitation and the Air Cargo Apron. Other projects were pursued aggressively at detail sites located in Holy Loch and Edzell, Scotland; Gaeta, Italy; La Maddalena, Sardinia; and Sigonella, Sicily
