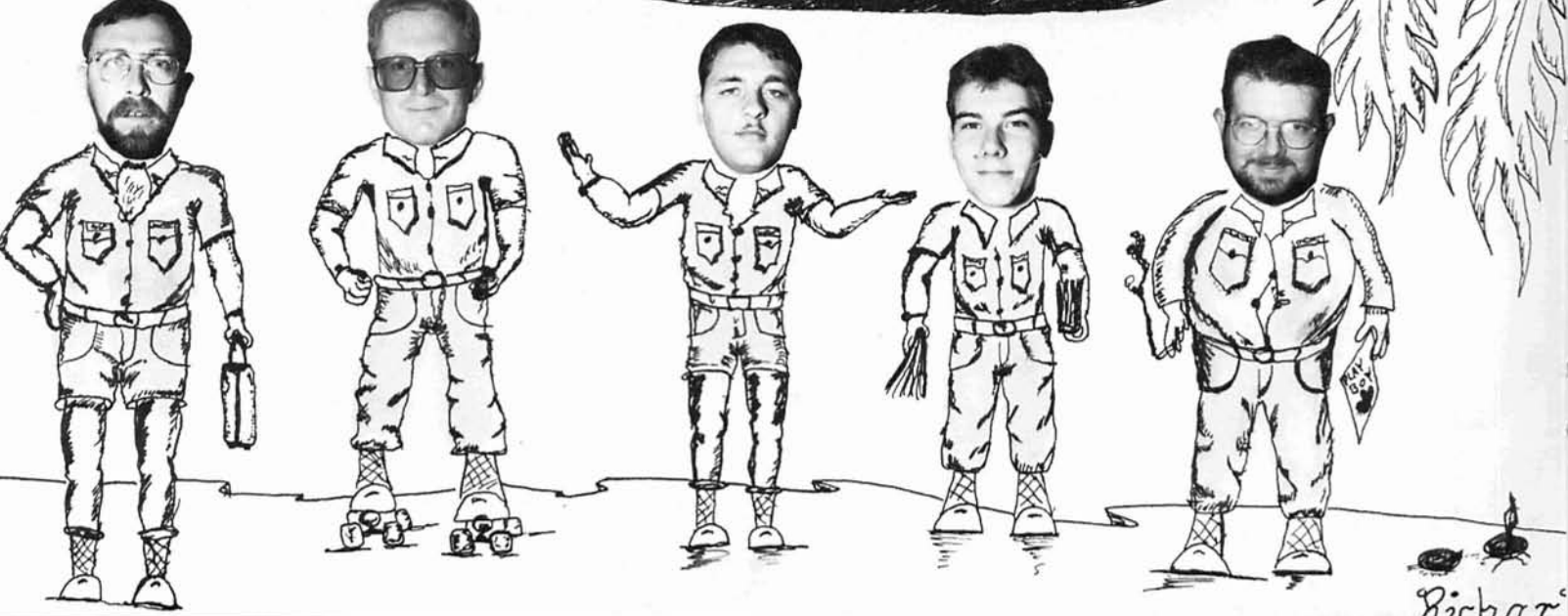
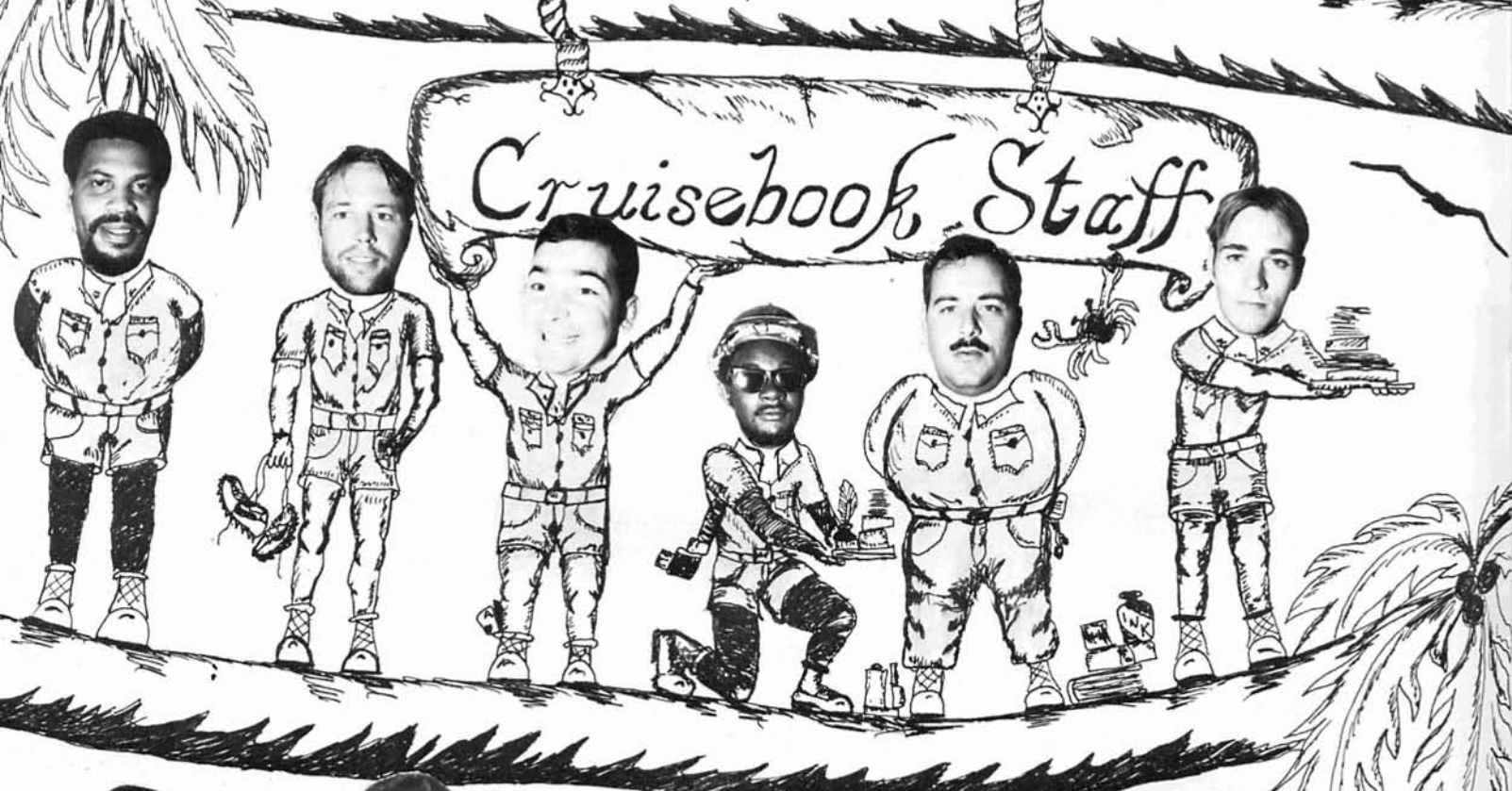
Military Training For The Minutemen On Diego
